Sting (on Orff Instruments)	Patsching (beat and rhythm) Sizzle the rhythm (tsss) Patsch the beat & sizzle the rhythm Call & response Sing melody on Da Scaffolding (play just the first beat of each phrase, one bar, one phrase, part 1, part 2, etc.) Colour code phrases Sing note names while playing In partners, play part 1 and part 2 as a duet Chunking Modelling, individual work and group work Play instrument backwards (mirror image to class)
Rhythmic Compositions	Write a 4 beat composition using ta, ti ti and rest Sizzle it Put it in your body (Body percussion) In groups of 4, combine your compositions to create 8 bars
My Bonnie Lies Over the Ocean (lyrics attached)	Every time a word starts with B, stand up (or sit down if you're already standing)

### **Key Concepts**

<b>Beat vs. Rhythm</b>	“The beat is the part that stays the same, the beat is the part that doesn't change.”
<b>Syncopation</b>	The beat doesn't always line up with the rhythm
<b>Staff</b>	5 lines When 2 staves are joined by a bracket, the music in each line happens at the same time
<b>Harmony</b>	2 notes happen at the same time
<b>Tie</b>	Two of the same note are joined (tied) together
<b>Bar</b>	Section between 2 vertical lines on the staff
<b>Phrase</b>	2 bar unit (in Sting)
