PODCAST ASSIGNMENT

YOUR STORY WITH MUSIC

TASK

Use audio editing software to produce a 3-5 minute podcast

- combine excerpts of personally significant pieces of music...
- with reflections on your relationship with music...
- at various points in your life.

WHY???

Learn the technology

- To familiarize you with the kind of audio technology employed in radio, film, TV, recording, composing, etc.
- So you can support students in working with this technology.

Explore personal interactions with music

- better understand your own relationship with music, and
- how your students may or might relate to music.

You could have your future students do this assignment

Podcasting may serve their expressive needs (or yours!)

You will actively re-engage with music that is meaningful to you.

PARAMETERS

- 3-5 minutes in length
- at least 5 significant pieces of music
- do not play more than 15 seconds of any one music clip without commentary over top
 - you are not a disc jockey—you are using the music to illustrate your story
- email the final version of the podcast to me as an mp3 file
 - make sure you listen to the mp3 in its entirety before you send it, to ensure it plays correctly!

TECHNICAL CONSIDERATIONS

- You need a computer with a built in microphone
 - (or find a microphone)
- I suggest Audacity www.audacityteam.org software
 - free download
 - available for both Windows and Mac
- Be sure to additionally install: <u>LAME MP3 encoder</u>
 - allows Audacity to export MP3 files
- Other audio editing software...
 - will also work, e.g., Garage Band, Cubase, etc.

PROCEDURE

- Brainstorm a list of personally significant interactions with music at various points in your life
 - see 'river of life' graphic organizer
- Identify specific music to represent these interactions,
 - collect mp3 versions of the pieces
- Write text (a paragraph or two) to accompany each musical excerpt
- Combine text and music using audio editing software
- Export podcast to mp3, check it plays correctly, then email it to me.
